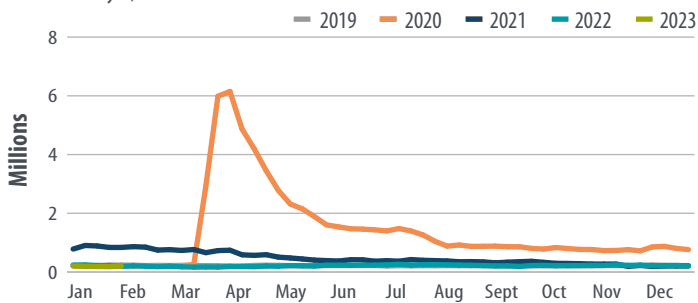

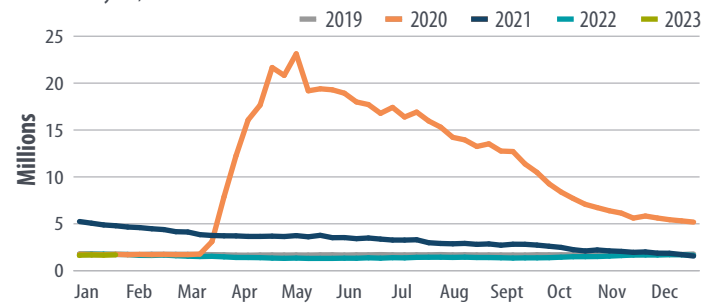

CONTINUING JOBLESS CLAIMS

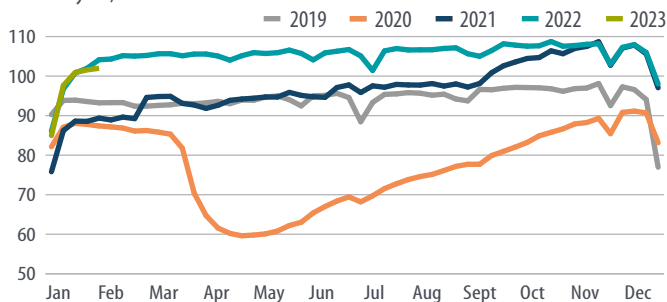

ASA STAFFING INDEX

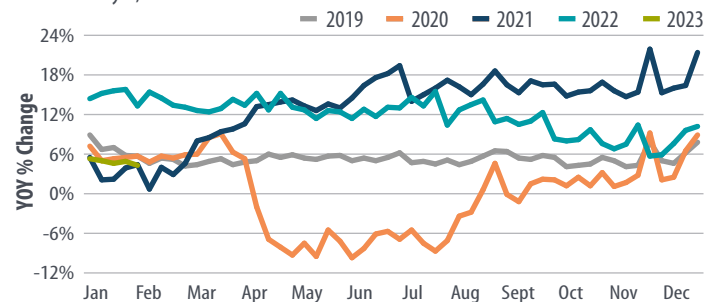

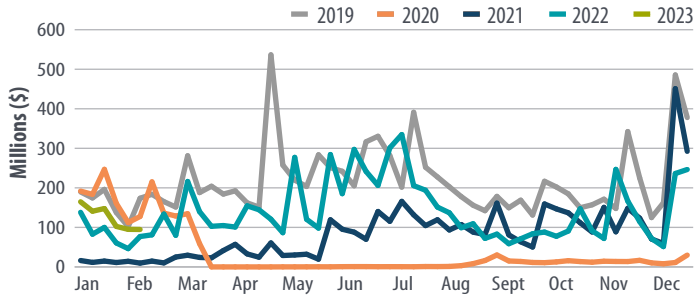

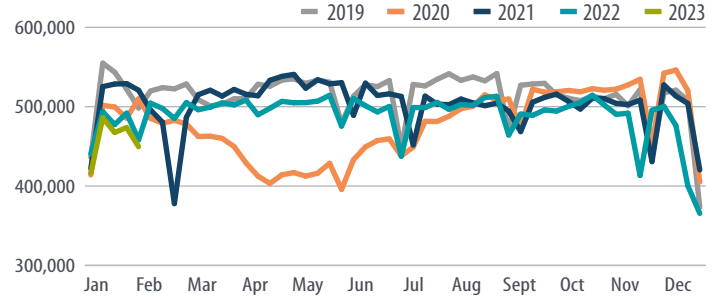

RAIL CAR TRAFFIC (CARS)

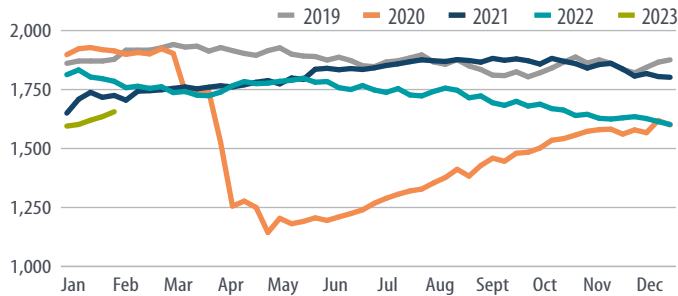

STEEL PRODUCTION (NET TONS)

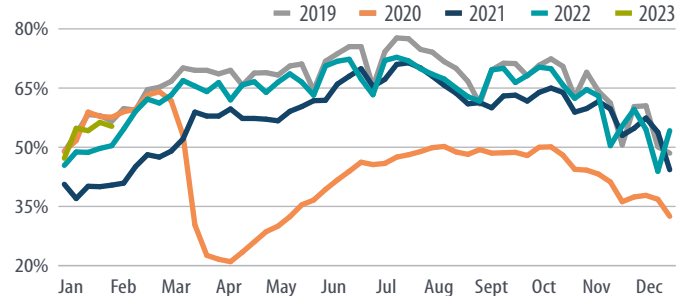

HOTEL OCCUPANCY

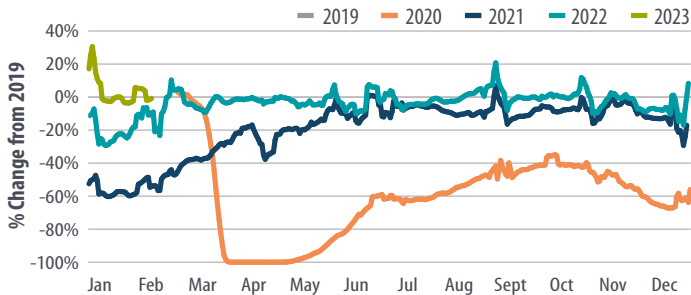

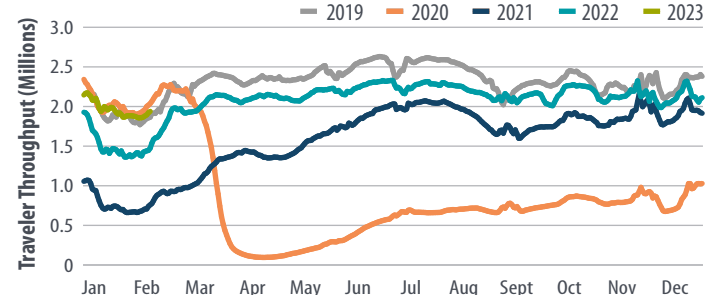

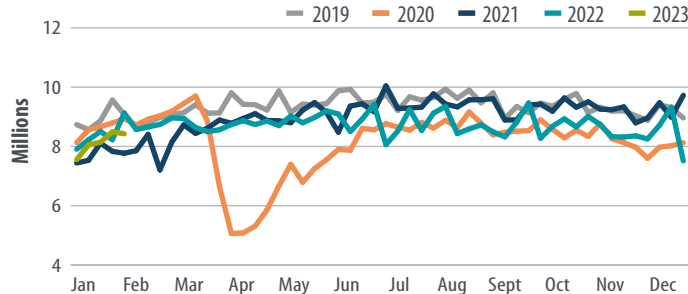

SUPPLY OF MOTOR GASOLINE IN THE U.S. (MGBL/D)

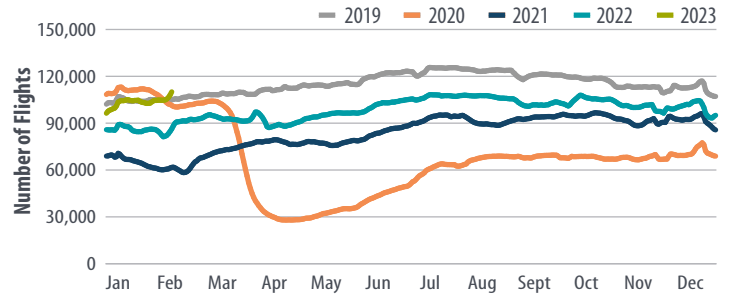
